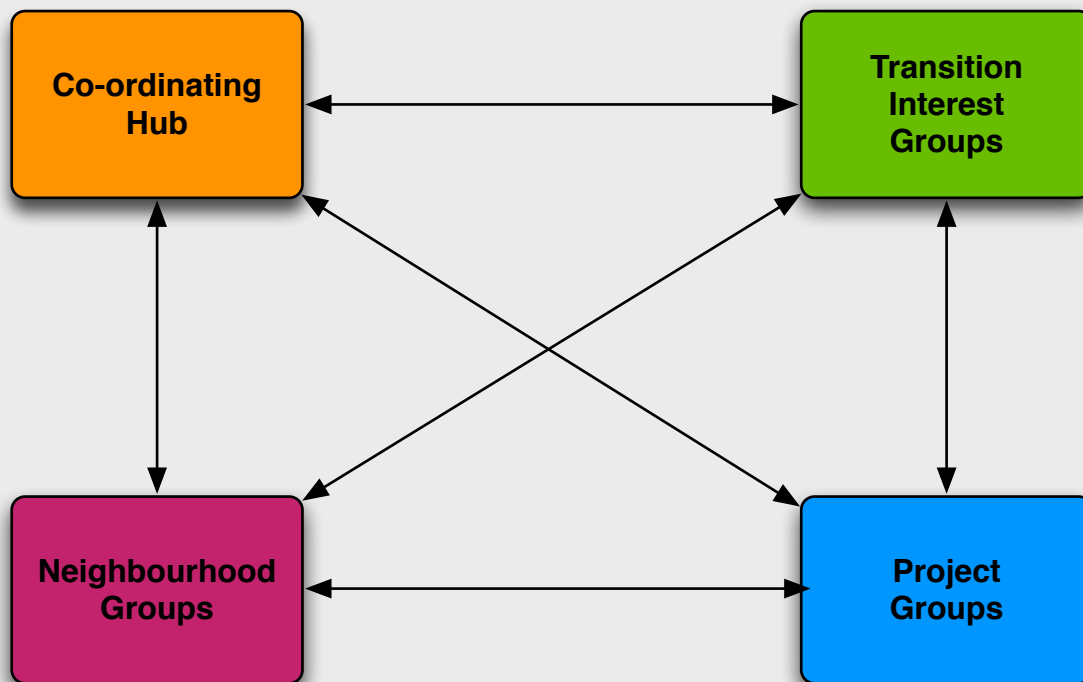


Transition Brighton & Hove

Top-Level Relationships



- Co-ordinating Hub** Oversees the general direction of TB&H, co-ordinates key decisions, maintains web site, handles requests for speakers and so on.
- Transition Interest Groups** Connects people with shared interests in a key target area for Transition (Energy, Food, etc), creating and maintaining links with other related groups outside TB&H, organising events and projects, giving advice on their interest area, writing their section of the Energy Descent & Resilience Action Plan.
- Neighbourhood Groups** Links people in a neighbourhood to promote and organise events, projects and support groups relating to the overall purpose of TB&H.
- Project Groups** Groups of people coming together to organise an event, produce educational or promotional materials, or implement projects within the overall Energy Descent & Resilience Action Plan.
